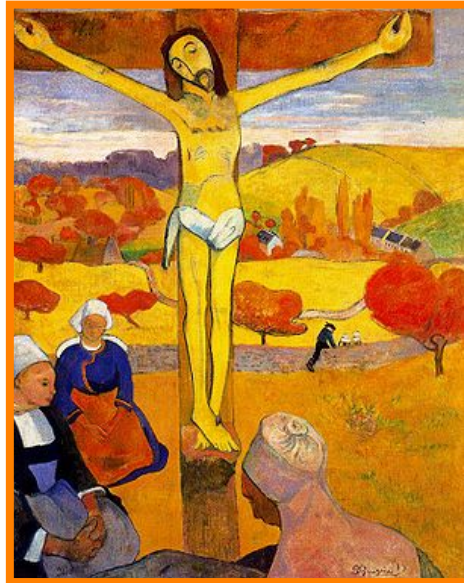


The Life of Christ through Art— Scenes of the Cross and Resurrection
